#### Late Policy:

## **Retesting Policy:**

Students can re-test missed questions on Summative Unit Exams, but not Mid-Unit Exams, Quizzes or the Final. In order to retake an exam a student must complete the objective sheet provided to them and attend one tutoring session or AO session with teacher. The student will earn ½ credit for each corrected question. AO sessions will be held in Room 114 with Coach O'Buck. The first AO period following the assessment will be for remediation. The second AO period following the assessment will be for reassessment.
