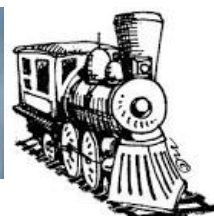

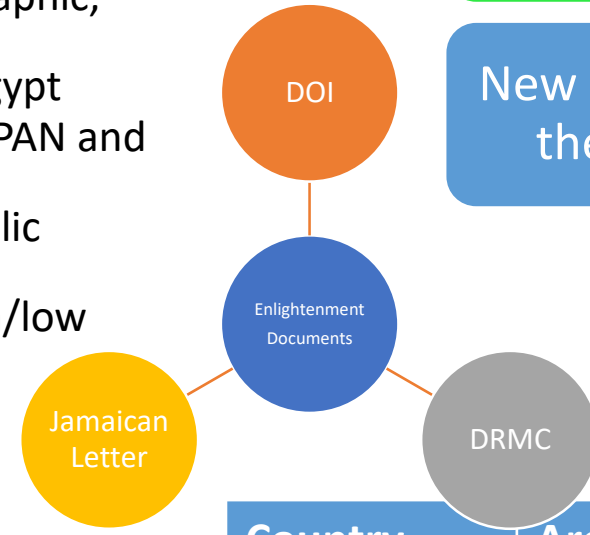

• Industrialization

- How goods are made- mechanization
- Two Phases – (2nd phase – steel, chemicals, electricity, precision machinery)
- Factory system → effects on gender, family structure, consumerism, specialization of labor, urbanization
- Export economies and urban centers (economic, demographic, social, cultural AND political shifts)
- Who is NOT industrializing? → Ottomans, China, India, Egypt
- Who IS industrializing? → Western Euro, US but also .. JAPAN and RUSSIA
- Urban Reforms: school, working conditions, suffrage, public health
- New social classes: Urban workers, business owners (high/low middle class)

• Imperialism

- White settler colonies vs. tropical dependencies
- Justification with racial ideologies – Social Darwinism

• Nationalism and Revolution

- Maroon societies, Boxer Rebellion
- Religious movements: Sioux Ghost Dance, Maji Maji Rebellion, Taiping Rebellion
- Rise of the nation-state: US, GM, IT, JP

• Global Migrations

- Enclaves → Anti-immigration movements

CHEROKEE NATION
(1794-1907)
LEGAL, AUTONOMOUS GOV'T RECOGNIZED BY THE USA. FORCIBLY MOVED IN 1838 (TRAIL OF TEARS)



BALKAN INDEPENDENCE
AS THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE DECLINED, TWELVE STATES EVENTUALLY FOUGHT/GAINED INDEPENDENCE INTO THE 20TH CE.



ZULU KINGDOM
(1816-1897)
KINGDOM IN SOUTHEAST SOUTH AFRICA FOUNDED BY SHAKA ZULU, THAT WAS LATER ABSORBED INTO SOUTH AFRICA.



SEPOY MUTINY
(1857)
SEPOYS UNSUCCESSFULLY REBELLED AGAINST BRITAIN
